## President's Message

This next Saturday, June 20<sup>th</sup> is our scheduled fun-fly. Please meet at the field by 8:00 am for the pilot's meeting when we will review the day's events and discuss the flying sequence and schedule. Kent Torgersen has once again agreed to run the transmitter impound. All pilots will be required to turn in their transmitters, including 2.4's during the day, and provide their AMA number and transmitter frequency. We are scheduled to start at 9:00 am until about 2:00 pm or so. As we have in the past, we will be selling concessions during the fun-fly, we will have a raffle, and airplane static display on the enclosed grass area. Please come and fly and we can use all of your help and assistance in making sure we have a safe and fun day. Pass the word around to your families and friends so that we can have a good turnout. It appears that the weather has a good chance cooperating with our fun-fly.

We hope to have all types of aircraft flying - electrics, nitro, gasoline powered motors and engines and expect to have a time for helicopter 3-D flying as well. If you would like to schedule a special time for flying, such as combat, wings, sail-planes, 3-D flying, or whatever, please contact Elwin Peck who has agreed to be the announcer for the event, if you would like to schedule your event. We will have periods of time when anyone can fly 3-4 at a time to let the spectators view the various types of aircraft we fly. We anticipate that we will even have a jet remote plane put on a demonstration and of course the lawn mower will fly at least once! Also, we would appreciate it if you would like to bring a trainer and trainer cords to have a few of the spectators try their hand at flying. We have extended an open invitation for anyone who has an active membership in the AMA who wants to fly, to come to our event. Of course, the AMA is required of all flyers and the sign-up sheet for the pilots will require us to give our AMA numbers.

We give a special thanks to those who assisted with the Saratoga Springs Splash Days fun-fly at the field. We had 3-4 trainers with trainer cords flying at the same time. Many were lined up to wait their turn to fly. We didn't even have any major crashes or mishaps! The crowd seemed to really enjoy the day.

Our Club meetings for July, August and possibly September will be held at the field, weather permitting. It is great to be able to meet at the field which can allow special flying instructions or demonstrations. We can also bring our extra stuff to sell for a swap meet. If you have any ideas for our meetings, please don't hesitate to contact any of the officers. Thanks again for your assistance - this is a great hobby!

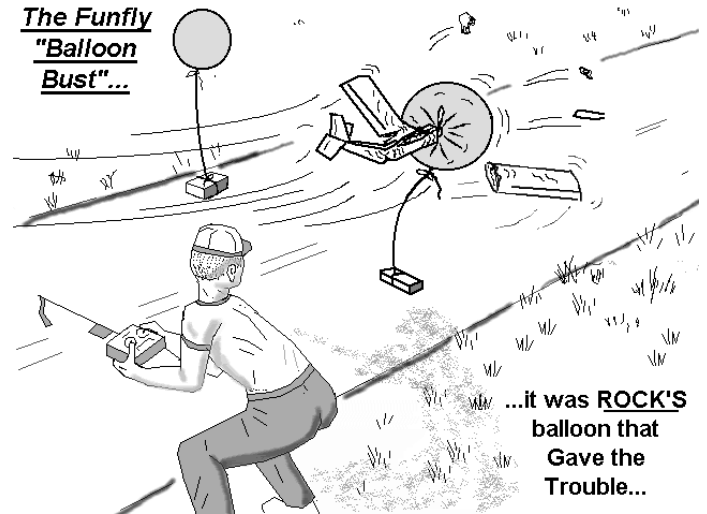

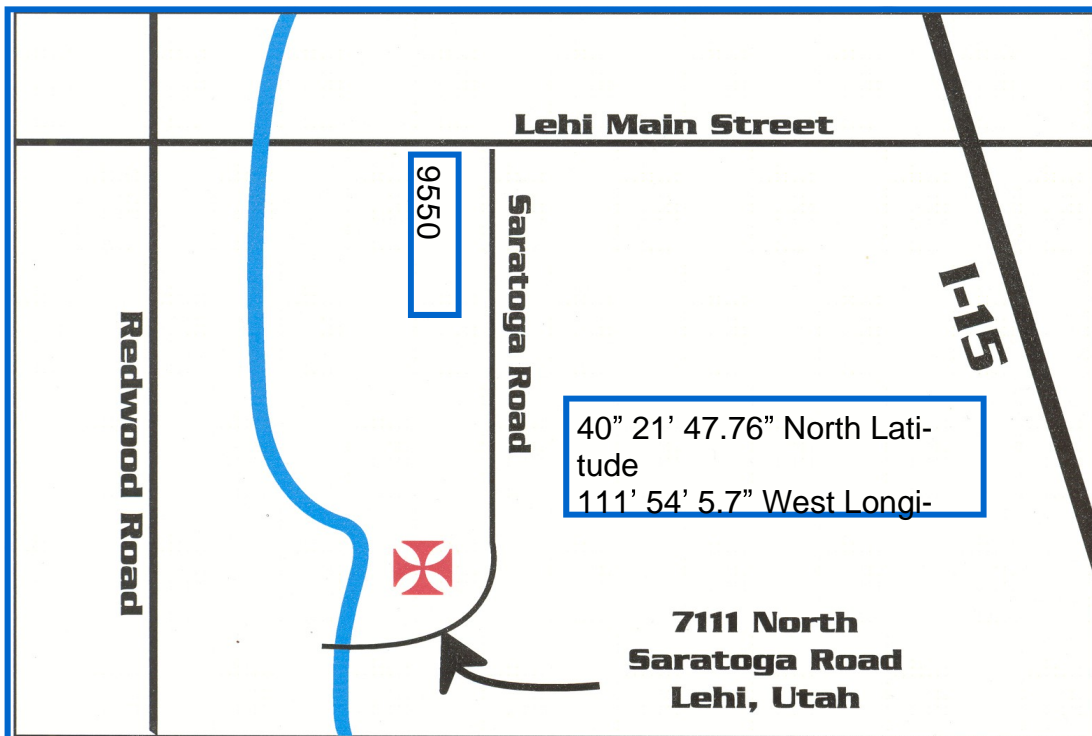

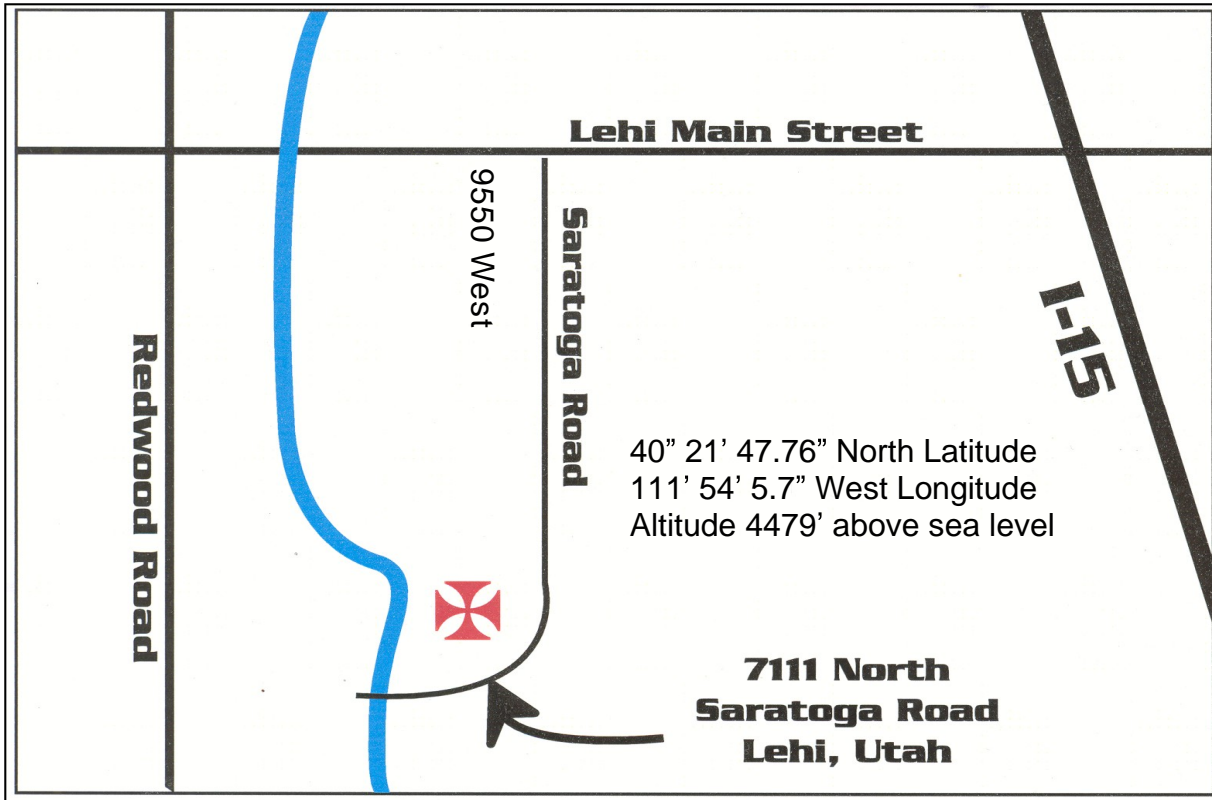
