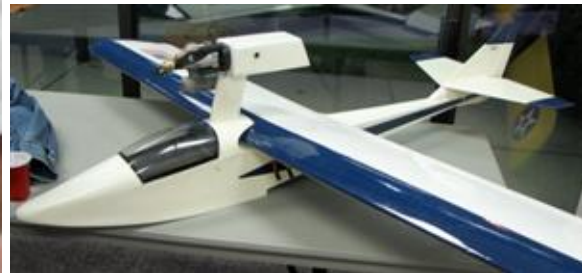
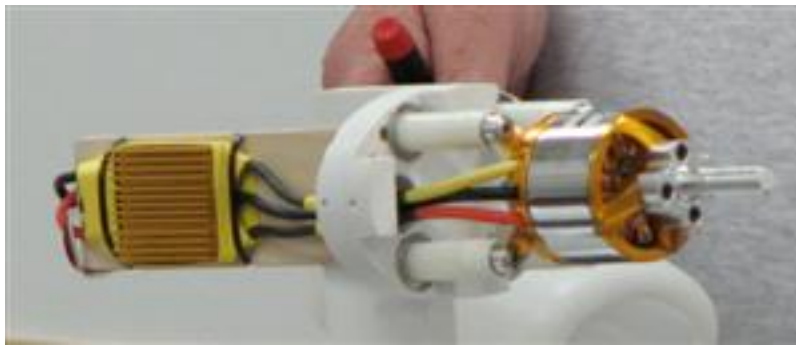
MAY MEETING RECAP
