Place: Golden Corral 8800 South Redwood Rd.

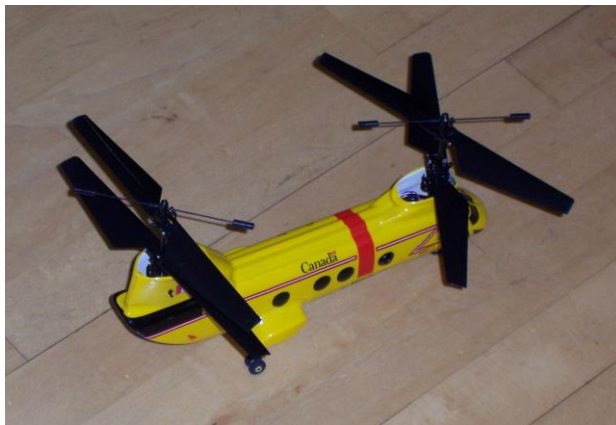
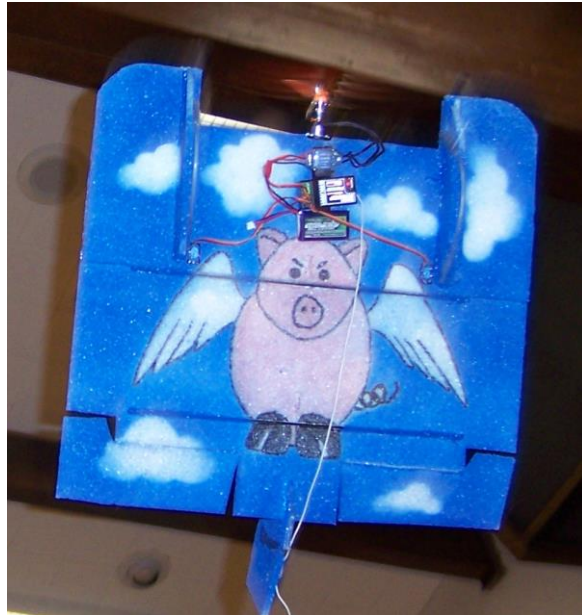
Time: 6:30 pm until everyone is full

Doug Dorton showed off his newest quad-copter, including an outdoor night flight demo!



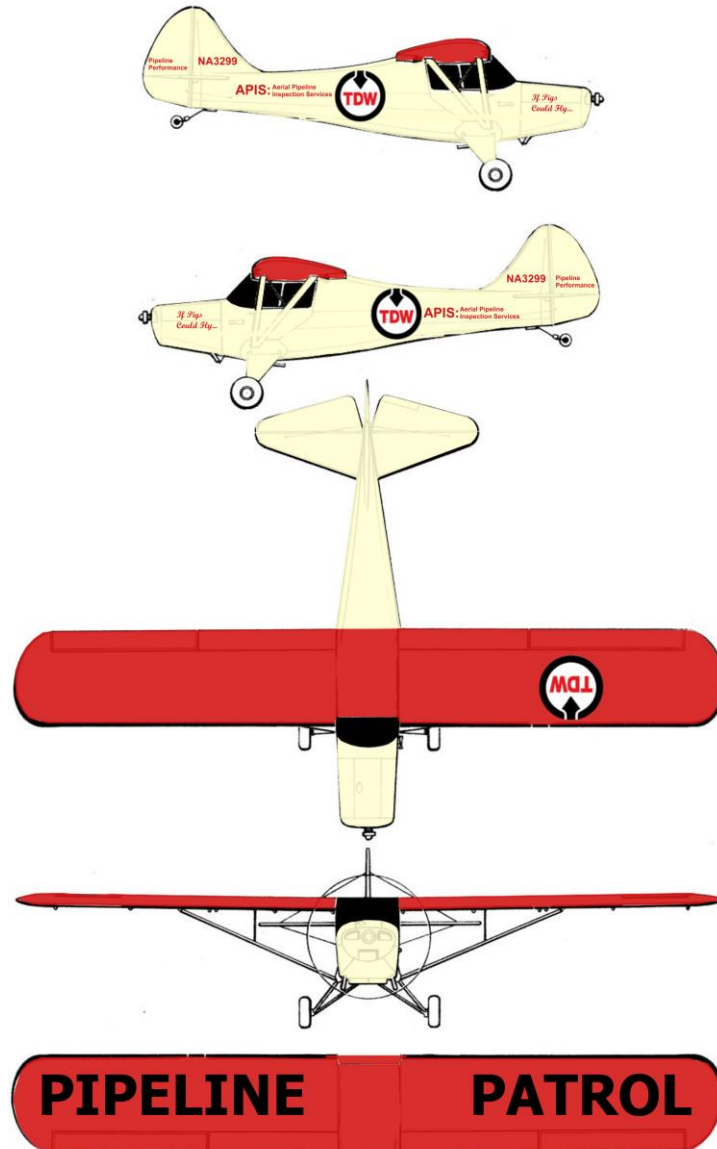
Jim Buchmann brought a couple of terrific aviation artifacts and led a short discussion on the EAA.
